JUNE 6, 2012

Meeting held at Eastwood Middle School

In attendance were Mark Dollase, Doug McKee, Don Melloy, Andy Seiwert, Joe Goeller, Steve Ferguson and Rollin Rhea. Guests were Sgt Rhonda, IMPD and Noelle Malatestinic, Neighborhood Liaison.

Sgt Rhonda discussed with the board the event that had occurred at the Villa Patee apartments. The shooter was from out of state and apparently mental illness was an issue. Occurrence of crime in this area is not as prevalent as this kind of event would indicate. The Sgt agreed to provide us with some comparative reports of other apartment complexes in the area.

Re: the Shell liquor permits application. The hearing is scheduled for Monday June 18. Ivy Hills and Sycamore Springs did respond to our requests to assist with the hearing. Main objections will be based on saturation of liquor outlets and community opposition. Need to contact the Marsh property owner at 82nd and Allisonville.
