President Sue Pfohl introduced Dr. Nikki Woodson, Superintendent of Washington Township Schools at 7:05 PM who, with her staff, presented information regarding the 2 referenda that will appear on the May 2020 ballot.

1. **Operating** totaling \$16 Million annually for 8 years or \$128 million for teachers, administrators, bus drivers, school police officers, additional staff, and more.
2. **Construction** totaling \$238 million for renovations & improvements to sustain for 20-30 years.

Dr. Woodson and WTS staff presented a slide show highlighting the WTS. Rather than summarizing an overwhelming amount of information, it might be best to visit their website which includes the slide show and more:
