Getting rid of sculptures. Lots of decks that can be easily removed. Some decks, like off kitchen, BRs will stay. Neighbors – thought it would be a lot worse. Neighbor mowing lawns. Likes 2-year leases. But... Zoned D2. D8 is multi family.

Parking open. Trees provide screen. Have hired an arborist who is making. No plan for gated community.

Elevation – needs to remove decks. Then color palatte. Windows lots of natural light.

Millersville/Fall Creek & Kessler community. Lots of past problems – construction without permits.

We do not know if any land use associations have voted.
